VISIT TO CAMBODIA BY SOUTH AUSTRALIAN MINISTER FOR INVESTMENT AND TRADE

South Australian Minister for Investment and Trade, the Hon Martin Hamilton-Smith MP, will visit Cambodia on 25-26 August 2017 to explore opportunities to strengthen trade and investment ties.

Minister Hamilton-Smith will be accompanied by a small business delegation. This is the first ministerial-led visit to Cambodia by a State trade delegation.

“Minister Hamilton-Smith’s visit is a great opportunity to explore ways we can boost trade and investment ties between South Australia and Cambodia,” Australian Ambassador Angela Corcoran said.

“South East Asia is a dynamic and emerging region with great economic potential. More trade and investment between Australia and Cambodia is good for businesses, good for our economies, and will support regional prosperity,” the Ambassador said.

While in Cambodia the Minister will meet with Minister for Education, Youth and Sport, HE Dr Hang Chuon Naron. The Ministers will officially open a new policy study centre located at the Royal University of Phnom Penh. This centre is a joint initiative with the University of Adelaide.

Minister Hamilton-Smith will also meet with senior Cambodian business representatives, and Cambodians who have studied in South Australia.

Minister Hamilton-Smith’s visit to Cambodia is part of a regional business mission to South East Asia under the Government of South Australia’s South East Asia Engagement Strategy.
