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Taste of Australia 2025 - Showcasing World Leading Premium Australian Produce

The Australian Embassy in Cambodia proudly launched the Taste of Australia 2025, an event that showcased Australia's world renowned, high quality premium food and wine offerings.

Held in Phnom Penh, the dinner brought together high-level government officials, business leaders and media representatives, together with prominent figures from Cambodia's premium culinary scene.

Guests were treated to a curated menu that featured choice ingredients included Wagyu beef from South Australia, grass-fed tenderloin from Queensland's Darling Downs, blue mussels and octopus from Western Australia and New South Wales, and Bangalow sweet pork from Byron Bay. These were paired with premium riesling, chardonnay, shiraz and cabernet shiraz wines from the Penfolds collection—showcasing some of Australia's most iconic wines.
