Secretary of the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, Ms Kathryn Campbell AO CSC and Bar, will visit Phnom Penh from 12-14 June. The visit takes place as Australia and Cambodia celebrate 70 years of diplomatic ties, and at a time when Cambodia chairs ASEAN.

Secretary Campbell will meet His Excellency Prak Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and other senior officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation during her visit.

Secretary Campbell will also meet His Excellency Dr Kao Kim Hourn, Minister Attached to the Prime Minister, and His Excellency Ly Thuch, Senior Minister and First Vice President of the Cambodian Mine Action and Victim Assistance Authority.

"Australia and Cambodia have a 70 year, longstanding and enduring relationship. We look forward to continuing to work together to address common regional and global challenges, and support Cambodia's ASEAN Chair Year. ASEAN's vision to support an open, inclusive and resilient Indo-Pacific is critical to our region," Secretary Campbell said.
